6. Discussion and approval of purchase of a sign at the Boat Landing for Ron Adler. Motion to contact Dew Signs and spend no more than \$400 for a 10 x 12 sign made by Moore, second by Behringer. Approved 5-0.
7. Presentation and approval of donation for Wild West Days. Natalie Beil presented and requested donation of \$400 from the Town of Mazomanie. Motion to approve made by Behringer, second by Moore. Approved 5-0.
8. Transfer site update provided by Ron Patterson, Site Superintendent. Currently have 519 paid t-site users, getting 4-10 weeks on overflow bin. Some concerns on sizing of recycling container, considering getting larger 40 yard.
